Important – you must not drive

We have received medical information that you have recently suffered a psychiatric illness so you should not drive at present.

This means that your entitlement to drive will be revoked (cancelled) from 2 February 2022. Your current driving licence must be returned to the DVLA at the address above.

The Secretary of State's Specialist Panel advises that stable good mental health is required for at least 3 months as well as maintaining satisfactory engagement with any recommended treatment. A longer period may be required if you suffer a relapse or the symptoms become focused on situations relevant to driving. You can consider re-applying* when your doctor is able to confirm that you meet these criteria.

We would suggest that you discuss this with your doctor. You will need to take this letter to show him/her as they may not be aware of the decision. You and your doctor can obtain more information about the current medical standards for driving from www.gov.uk/dvla/fitnesstodrive

Please Note:

If you have any additional medical information that was not considered as part of this enquiry we may be able to review your case. Please send it to Further Evidence, CCU30, DGFW, DVLA, SA99 1ZZ and quote our reference at the top of this letter.

You can appeal to the courts against this decision. You should do this at:

- your local Magistrates' court within 6 months of this notice if you live in England or Wales' or
- your local Sheriffs Court within 21 days of this notice if you live in Scotland.
